About Hostos STEP

Proyecto access is a year-round program originally funded by NASA (The National Aeronautics and Space Administration) at Hostos Community College. The main objective is to increase the number of minority graduates in STEM majors.

Currently, the program is sponsored by the New York State education Department, serving more than 282 high achieving underrepresented/ economically-disadvantaged secondary school students with the potential to become engineers or scientist.

The program offers enrichment courses to middle and high school students in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. In addition, students work on different engineering projects including the tower project, the bridge project, and a robotics competition with a potential to participate in the annual step statewide student conference.
