About Us

Projecto Access is a year-round program originally funded by The National Aeronautics and Space Administration (NASA) and developed by the Hispanic Association of Colleges and Universities (HACU) in 1996 at Hostos Community College. The main objective of the program is to increase the number of minority graduates in STEM majors. Currently, the program is sponsored by the New York State Education Department, serving each year 301 high achieving underrepresented/ economically disadvantaged secondary school students with the interest in STEM Careers.

The program offers enrichment courses to middle and high school students in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics. In addition, students work on different science and engineering projects including tower, bridge, and robotics projects, with the potential to participate in the Annual STEP Statewide Student Research Conference.
